Transportation from/to the airport

Athens's airport metro station is located at the airport's second level, at the Departures area. The station building is connected to the main terminal via an elevated passageway. Elevators are also on tap for passengers with reduced mobility or lots of luggage. Please follow the airport's signage “To Trains”.

A one-way subway ticket from Athens Airport to Syntagma Square costs 9€/10\$ for adult passengers and 4.50€/5.22\$ for children, students, and elders. The price for a return ticket is 16€/18.56\$, while children under 6 years old travel for free.

You can purchase your tickets at the airport station ticket booths or through the automatic machines at each station.

Alternatively, if you are planning to wander around the city during your visit, you should buy a 3-day Tourist ticket, valid for buses, metro, and tram. The 3-day ticket includes a return ticket to Athens Airport and costs 20€/23.19\$.

Athens's airport subway trains run day after day, from 06:10 am to 11:34 pm, with available routes every 36 minutes.

The Athens metro system consists of three lines (Blue, Red and Green). The Blue line connects the center of Piraeus with Athens International Airport, the Red line connects the areas (and between) Elliniko and Anthoupoli and the Green line which is overground train connects the port of Piraeus with the northern suburb of Kifisia. There are common stations where someone can change line.

Transportation to/from the venue

You may reach the venue by bus, train, or taxi.

Train-Green line: Kallithea Electric Station
From Kallithea Station the venue is 5-7 minutes by taxi.

Bus lines that can drop you off to the bus stop “School of Fine Arts” which is a 3 minutes walk from the venue:

Bus No 049 - Line Piraeus-Omonia
Bus No 914 - Line Omonia-Piraeus

The taxis in Athens have a taximeter and the fare depends mainly on distance and the traffic.

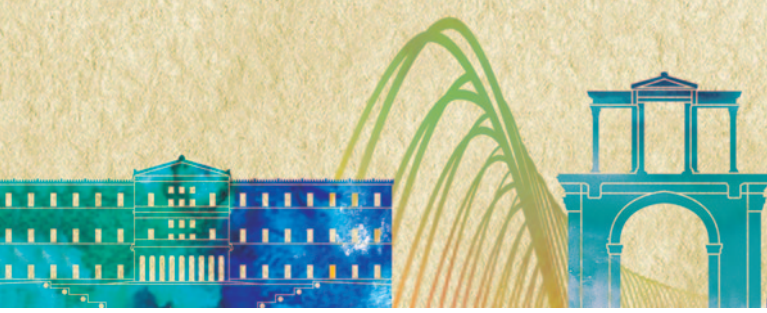
